PICTURE MAKE UP DAY	Lifetouch Studios will be in Room 101 for faculty and makeup portraits on Wednesday, September 27. STUDENT PARKING PERMITS	Starting this week, students will be required to have a student-parking permit to park in the student lot. To obtain a FREE permit, you will need your driver’s license, current registration and proof of insurance. Bring them to the attendance window before school or at lunch.
LUNCH DELIVERIES	Students are reminded that lunch deliveries from delivery services such as Lyft and Uber Eats are not allowed at lunchtime or any other time during the day. Lunch deliveries will be confiscated and held in the main office until the end of the school day. Deliveries are a safety concern for everyone. Parents may only deliver lunches in person and must deliver the meal to the main office prior to the start of lunch. Students are not permitted beyond the 100 building during the lunch period to pick up food. Administration.

PARKING LOT	Warhawks, the parking lots are off-limits during the school day. Be sure to get what you need out of your vehicle when you arrive in the morning as you will not be permitted to go to the parking lot in between classes or at lunch.
SELLING ITEMS ON CAMPUS	Students ARE NOT permitted to sell ANY items on school campus. This includes any food items, drink items, or any other items. Anything that is being sold on campus MUST go through Admin and ASB and be approved prior to selling. If you are caught

	selling items on campus without following the proper protocol you will be referred to Administration.
CLOSED CAMPUS	Warhawks, Madison High School is a closed campus. You may not leave campus during the school day without your parent/guardian excusing you for a necessary appointment. You may not leave campus for any reason during lunch. Students found leaving or returning to campus without parent permission will be issued a citation for truancy and have other school consequences.
