STUDENT PARKING PERMITS	Starting this week, students will be required to have a student-parking permit to park in the student lot. LUNCH DELIVERIES	Students are reminded that lunch deliveries from delivery services such as Lyft and Uber Eats are not allowed at lunchtime or any other time during the day. Lunch deliveries will be confiscated and held in the main office until the end of the school day. Deliveries are a safety concern for everyone. Parents may only deliver lunches in person and must deliver the meal to the main office prior to the start of lunch.
